

Car Parking Instructions
Sunday 25th June 2017

Please read the following instructions carefully to ensure that parking is carried out efficiently and safely.

There are two car parks, which are clearly marked as “Car Park 1” and “Car Park 2” on the map in the programme.

There is no parking on the roadside along Ferriby Road and Heads Lane; please park in the official car parks.

Half Marathon and Fun Run runners approaching from Hull and the East should travel along Boothferry Road (A1105) before turning left down Heads Lane. You will then be directed into Hessle High School’s car park (**Car Park 1**) on the left. There will be no access to Heads Lane after 8.45am, therefore if you arrive after this time you will be directed west along Boothferry Road to enter Ferriby Road to go into car park 2.

All other competitors approaching from the South (A15), West (M62/A63) and North (A164) will be directed to the Humber Bridge roundabout and then West along Boothferry Road to the roundabout linking the A63, Boothferry Road and Ferriby Road (this includes cars arriving from the A63, which will not be able to turn right at the roundabout into Ferriby Road, but will be directed to the Humber Bridge roundabout and then back to the Ferriby Road turn off). Turn left into Ferriby Road and park as directed by marshals. Most cars will be directed along Ferriby Road to turn left into Heads Lane to park in **Car Park 1**; some cars will be directed into **Car Park 2** (Hesslewood Business Park).

Runners parking in Hesslewood Business Park are respectfully asked to avoid inconvenience to the residents of the Care Home on the site. Parking is not permitted in their car park.

Please ensure that you arrive in good time as there will be severe congestion in the hour before the Half Marathon starts. Car Parks will open at **7.00am**. It is recommended that you aim to be parked by 8.15am at the very latest. Toilets are available in the Hesslewood Business Park car park and in the lorry car park near the start line.

Car park 1 will close and be locked at 2.00pm. Please ensure that you leave before this time.

Please note that all cars are parked at the owner’s risk. The organizers of the Half Marathon are not responsible for any damage to cars or other property belonging to runners.
